# Donations to charity — 2024

As we have grown as an organisation, one thing that has come through from our people is the desire to bring things to life that represent the unique ethos of their respective cities and regions. Empowering local teams fosters inclusivity and ensures that our cultural narrative is diverse, reflective and relevant – even in our constantly evolving world.

Donations to causes S<sup>4</sup>Capital and Monks support supports increased 20.5% compared to 2023. Hours donated to community and charity services significantly increased, up 119.7%.

As climate change continues to contribute to a growing number of catastrophes globally, we remain committed to reducing greenhouse gas emissions and achieving net zero by 2040 while also supporting relief efforts through monetary donations.
